

Psychiatry Services: Exclusion Criteria

Psychiatric providers at Sherman Counseling do not provide the following services:

- Disability evaluations
- Forensics evaluations, for civil or criminal suits
- Competency evaluations
- Evaluation for child custody and/or visitation rights
- Evaluations for surgery clearance
- Suboxone or methadone treatment

We do not provide services to:

- Patients without an established primary care provider
- Patients who are unwilling to sign a release of information to allow collaboration with their primary care provider and therapist
- Patients with dementia
- Patients under the age of 18 years old, or the geriatric population
- Patients under a civil commitment
- Patients who are under guardianship
- Patients who have a close relationship with an established patient already in care (conflict of interest) or with an employee of Sherman Counseling.

The following conditions often require specialized treatment that we are unable to provide: personality disorders, chronic pain, eating disorders, substance abuse, dissociative identity disorder. If these are the primary concerns, please seek treatment in a specialized treatment Program.
